- Construction has begun on the new Hastings Elementary school and state-of-the-art plans have been approved for the new Acton Elementary
- Technology has completed more than \$13 million in network upgrades as part of the \$102.545 million bond referendum
- The Duncanville Pantherettes girls basketball team is a powerhouse led by nationally-acclaimed Head Coach and Athletic Director Cathy Self-Morgan. The team won the Texas State Championship two consecutive years-2012 and 2013
- Coach Morgan is a 2015 inductee to the Texas Basketball Hall of Fame
- The Duncanville High School Marching Band is the only 5A band in Texas to advance to the State Marching Band Contest every contest year since 1988
- The district received a rating of “Superior Achievement” for 11 consecutive years under the Texas’ Schools FIRST financial accountability rating system
- Famous Duncanville High School graduates include Governor Greg Abbott, Olympic-gold medalist and WNBA champion, Tamika Catchings, and NBA center, Greg Ostertag
